Instead, I pay attention. I stay present. I adapt to the moment—even when it doesn't go to plan.

But that's exactly what I love about it.

No two sessions are ever the same. Each one is shaped by the horse, the person, the weather, the light, the location, ... And that's what makes it feel so real and unique each and every time.


